Why Should I Become a Certified Community Driver?

Volunteering with MTM is an excellent way to give back to your community while setting your own hours. Join MTM’s Community Driven Program to achieve personal growth and satisfaction while enjoying:

- The chance to help passengers retain independent living, dignity, and freedom
- Training opportunities
- Mileage reimbursement for your services
- The ability to set your own schedule

How Will I be Paid?

As a certified community driver, you will receive reimbursement based upon the mileage of each trip you take. As you pick up and drop off passengers, you will complete a trip log that will be submitted to MTM each week. Using the information on your log, payment will be determined based on the number of trip legs you complete and the distance of those trip legs.

How Do I Sign Up for the Community Driven Program?

Signing up to be a certified community driver is easy! MTM will guide you every step of the way to make sure you submit the right information and receive appropriate training. Before taking trips as a certified community driver, you must meet the following requirements:

General Requirements

- Have a current valid driver’s license
- Be at least 21 years of age
- Maintain adequate car insurance
- Complete a drug test and background check
- Have a professional, courteous demeanor at all times
- Maintain good hygiene

Equipment Requirements

- Have your own four-door vehicle that is safe, clean, and well maintained (must pass an initial and annual vehicle inspection)
- Have a cellular phone
- Maintain access to an email address and the internet

Training and Skills Requirements

- Ability to work with all kinds of people
- Ability to read, write, and communicate effectively in English
- Excellent customer service skills
- Complete an MTM, Inc. sponsored driver training course
